In accordance with Letter of Understanding between BLET and BNSF dated January 26, 2005, mileage is to be indexed in the **Superior-Dilworth ID** pool headquartered at **Superior, Wisconsin** as follows:

It is understood that the <u>Superior-Dilworth ID</u> Pool will be regulated on a once a week basis on <u>Tuesdays at 12:01 PM and when required, exempting Saturdays and Sundays, based on Changes in Train frequency</u> with line miles to be regulated between <u>3953</u> line miles and <u>4352</u> line miles. Average miles below <u>3953</u> will require turns to be taken out to achieve a <u>3953-4352</u> regulation. Average miles above <u>4352</u> will require turns to be added to achieve a <u>3953-4352</u> regulation. Pursuant to Paragraph 601.9 of Labor Agreement BN 4/24/81, OPS-36-81 (600 Rules), this weekly check will be accomplished by counting the line miles accumulated in the <u>15/10</u> days preceding the check day and multiplying that total by <u>2/3</u>. The resulting mileage total will be divided by the number of engineers' turns to determine average miles for the purpose of making such adjustments as may be necessary.
